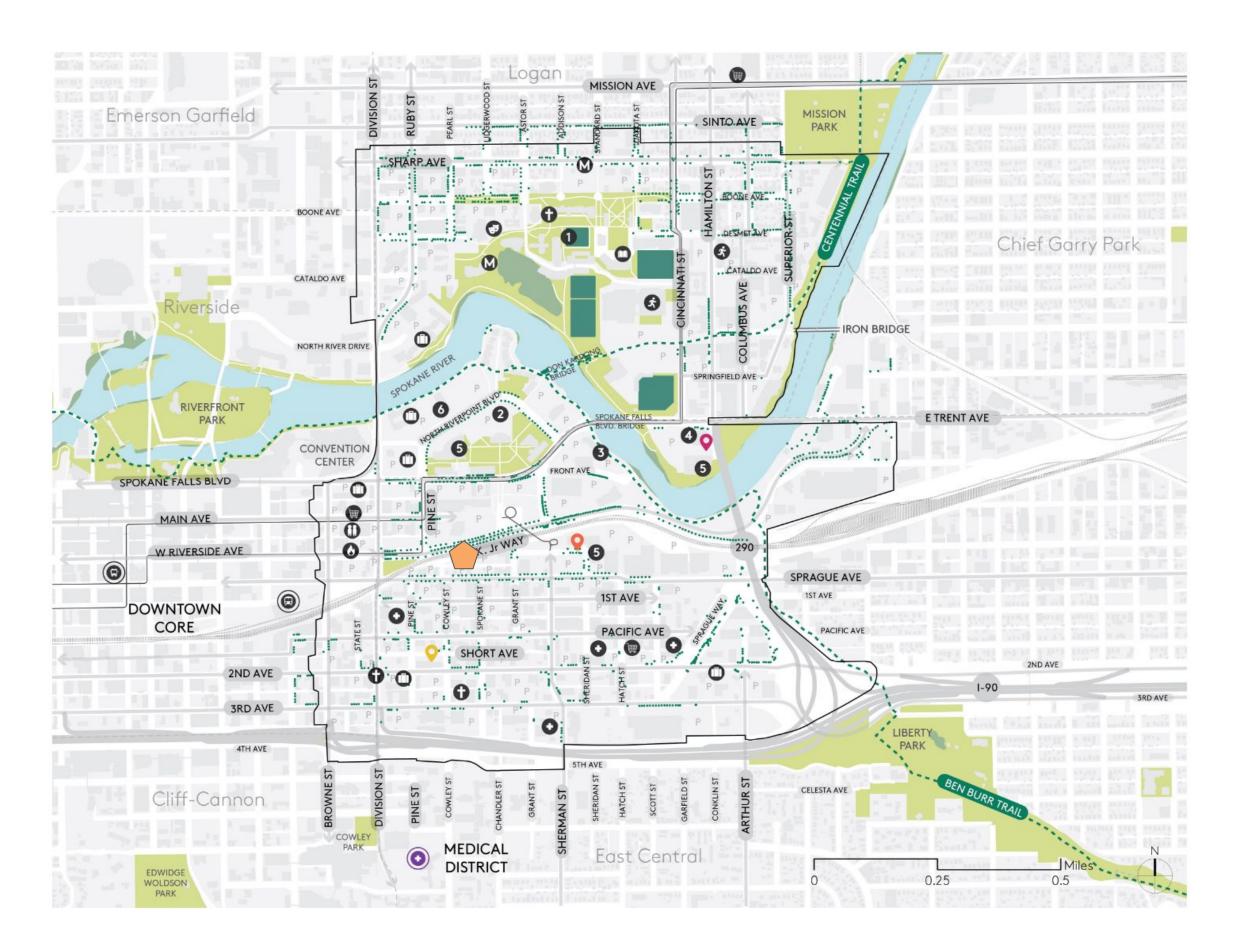

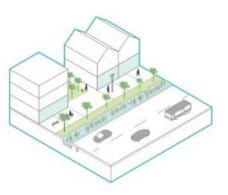

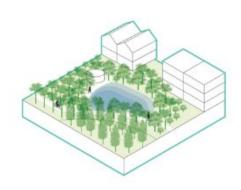

BLUE-GREEN Infiltration and stormwater infrastructure including greenways /curbless streets/ rain gardens and permeable pavement

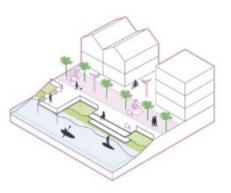

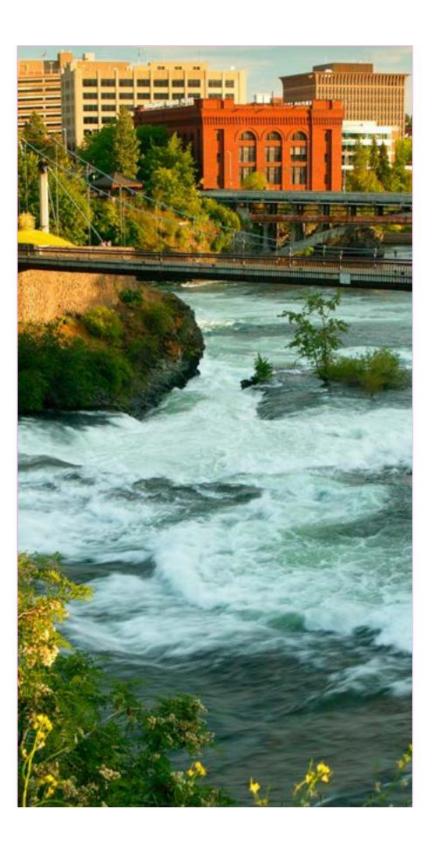
DESIGN GOALS —

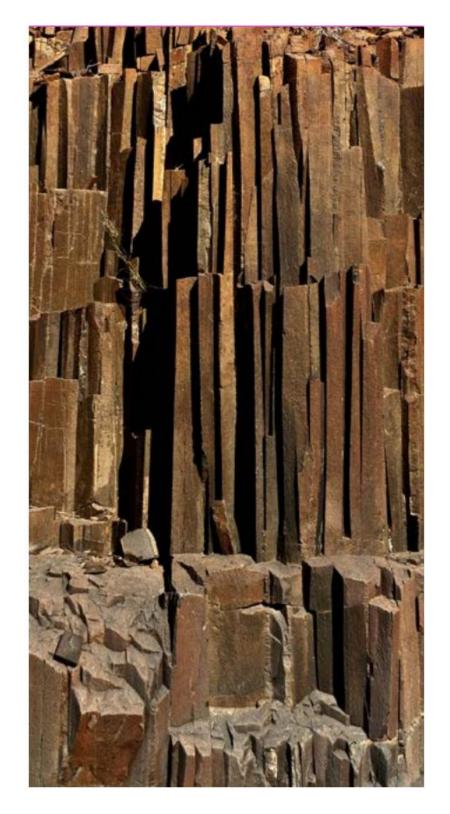


- Utilize the most economical and appropriate building systems for each program element
